Cookies

Our Site uses "cookies". A cookie is a very small piece of information that a website sends to your computer when you access the site. This information is stored by your browser, and accessed each time you visit the site. When you return to our Site, we detect whether you have one of our cookies on your computer and use this information to provide additional functionality to the Site and help us analyze Site usage more accurately. For example, our Site sets a cookie on your browser that allows you to access restricted pages of the site once you log in. You can disable cookies by changing the settings in your browser (See "Managing Cookies").

We utilize certain analytics applications which use third-party cookies to track visitor interactions with our Site. These analytics applications collect information anonymously and report Site trends without identifying individual visitors. These types of cookies cannot be used to track you once you leave our Site.

Cookies used on the Website

Following is a list of the different types of cookies and how they are used on our Site. See "Managing Cookies" should you want to disable the use of cookies with our Site.

Strictly Necessary Cookies: These types of cookies enable services you have specifically asked for. For those types of cookies that are strictly necessary, no consent is required.

- These types of cookies are essential in order to enable you to move around our Site and use its features, such as accessing secure areas of the Site. Without these cookies services you have asked for, such as private, secure access to Challenge Details, cannot be provided.

Performance Cookies: These types of cookies collect anonymous information on the pages visited. By using the Site, you agree that we can place these types of cookies on your device.

- These types of cookies collect information about how visitors use the Site, such as which pages visitors go to most often. These cookies enable us to collect aggregate, anonymous information. The aggregated information is only used to improve how the Site works.

Functionality Cookies: These types of cookies remember choices you make to improve your experience. By using the Site, you agree that we can place these types of cookies on your device.

- These cookies allow the Site to remember choices you make, such as your user name, and provide enhanced, more personal features. These cookies can also be used to

remember changes you have made to parts of the Site that you can customize, such as how lists are sorted. The information these cookies collect is only used to improve your experience on the site and cannot track your browsing activity on this or other sites.

Targeting or Advertising Cookies: These types of cookies collect information about your browsing habits in order to customize advertising to you and your interests.

- Our Site does not use targeting or advertising cookies.

Managing Cookies

All browsers allow you to fine-tune cookie settings and determine which ones to accept and which to disable or delete. Your browser can also notify you when you receive new cookies and allows to you to take action. Consult your browser's Help section for more information on adjusting its cookie settings.

Cookies allow you to take advantage of some of our Site's essential features, so we recommend you leave them turned on. If you block or otherwise reject cookies the Site may not function correctly and you may not be able to access restricted parts of the site that require you to log in. If you leave cookies turned on, remember to sign off when you finish using a shared computer.
